STREETS SAFE endeavors to prevent injury and save lives through educational classroom instruction, hand's-on driving exercises and parental involvement to change our teens driving behavior.

STREETS SAFE is taught by law enforcement and fire personnel, the men and women who are all too familiar with the tragic results of inexperience behind the wheel. Under their supervision, students will witness and experience:

- Speed control - students experience losing control of a vehicle at 25 mph
- Tailgating - students are taught a realistic stopping distance
- Evasive - students experience the inability to perform simple driving tasks while using a cell phone or other distraction
- Fatal Vision - students experience the effects of sensory impairment and how inebriation causes crashes
- Seatbelt Convincer - simulates a 5-8 mph crash emphasizing seatbelt use
- The "No Zone" - Tractor-Trailer demonstration raises awareness of necessary precautions to be taken and the truck drivers perspective
- There will also be discussions for both young drivers and their parents with a District Court Judge and a past president of NC Driver Education Association.
